In Carcassonne, southern France, a police officer died last Saturday morning. Just after 10am last Friday, Radouane Lakdim, 25, a Moroccan who lived in Carcassonne, stopped a white Opel Corsa car. The criminal shot and killed a person in the car and seriously hurt the driver. Then he drove off to a police office building and started shooting at four officers who were jogging. He finally drove to a supermarket in Trebes, a town near Carcassonne. At about 11am, he walked into the shop shouting Allahu Akbar. Then Lakdim killed one supermarket worker and one customer.

Policemen tried to take the people out of the supermarket. A police officer offered to take the people's place. The gunman agreed. The police officer, named Arnaud Beltrame, went into the supermarket and left his mobile phone line open on a table. Policemen heard a shot and they ran into the supermarket. They killed the criminal but found Arnaud Beltrame seriously injured.
